<input type="checkbox"/>	<i>Brachycome multifida</i>	CUT-LEAF DAISY	10cm, suckering, mauve daisy all year, hardy.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<i>Clematis aristata</i>	AUSTRAL CLEMATIS	Vigorous, often climbing. Masses of creamy flowers.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<i>Geranium sp.</i>	CRANE'S BILL	Spreading, often climbing. Tiny white or pink flowers.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<i>Glycine tabacina</i>	VANILLA GLYCINE	Creeping, purple flower sprays Summer.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<i>Goodenia lanata</i>	TRAILING GOODENIA	Hairy trailing herb. Attractive solitary yellow flowers.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Stylidium graminifolium	GRASS TRIGGER PLANT	Tufted, attractive pink flower spikes to 1m.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Hedycarya angustifolia	AUSTRAL MULBERRY	Shiny green foliage shaded moist site.

Large Trees (Over 10m)

<input type="checkbox"/>	Acacia mearnsii	BLACK WATTLE	Pale yellow flowers, dark green foliage.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Acacia melanoxylon	BLACKWOOD	Pale yellow flowers in Spring, 8-30m.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus baxteri	BROWN STRINGYBARK	Medium-tall tree, rough bark. Moist, well drained site.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus camphora	MOUNTAIN SWAMP GUM	Medium tree to 20m. Dark bark at base.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus rubida	CANDLEBARK	Smooth, white bark to 25m with ribbon bark.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus regnans	MOUNTAIN ASH	Very tall, long ribbon bark. Requires deep soils.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus yarraensis	YARRA GUM	Medium tree with short trunk to 20m. Rare.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus cephalocarpa	SILVER-LEAF STRINGYBARK	Medium tree, spreading crown, moister sites.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus cypellocarpa	MOUNTAIN GREY GUM	Tall, smooth barked gum, moist forest areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus goniocalyx	LONG LEAF BOX	Small-medium tree, large green leaves drier areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus ignorabilis	SCENT BARK	Large rounded crown, drier sites.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus macrorhyncha	RED STRINGYBARK	Small-medium tree, stringy bark for drier sites.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Eucalyptus obliqua	MESSMATE STRINGYBARK	Medium-tall, rough barked, drier-moist areas.
